2/ The FY 2013 Appropriation provided \$3.471 billion, the same level as provided in FY 2012 which was then reduced by 6.2% as result of sequestration (5%)

3/ The Adm. Budget would reduce total funding to \$3 billion of which \$150 million would go for emergency funds and \$50 million for a new competitiveness to reduce energy costs.

4/ The Senate Appropriations bill would provide \$3.615 billion of which \$496 million would be allocated by the "new" formula with the remaining amount allocated by the "new" formula.
